SIRIUS COLLEGE'S STORY

Understanding the importance of giving and how every little bit can help make a big difference in another person's life is one of the reasons why Sirius College in Keysborough supports the Good Friday Appeal.

From starting in 2011 with a donation of \$500, staff and students of the College have grown their fundraising and in 2019 presented a cheque for \$4,500!

The College's mission to empower their students to be socially responsible individuals is evident in their multiple fundraising activities for the Appeal each year. The College organises activities including free dress days, a movie night, sausage sizzles, food stalls, crazy hair days and in 2019 held their very first Toastie Day and Colour Run. Students

participate through a gold coin donation. Saniye Coskundag, Secondary Girls Coordinator, says that in the future the College has even more ideas on how to raise money for the Good Friday Appeal and encourages other schools to think about their fundraising options.

"It is very rewarding to know that the small amount of fundraising our students do makes a change in the wider community. We live in a very fortunate country where we get what we want so rather than 'me' it should be about 'you'. It teaches students to have empathy."
