JOIN THE PIED PIPERS

The Pied Pipers, one of our amazing Authorised Collection Groups, has been supporting the Good Friday Appeal for over 50 years with their annual School Door Knock Campaign and they're always looking for new schools to join them. HOLD A SPORT CHALLENGE

School fun runs are one of the most popular fundraising ideas as there is no upfront cost or products to sell. Instead of running you could try walking, riding, bouncing, skipping or many other sport challenges.

COLLECT AND RECYCLE CANS AND BOTTLES

With Victoria's Container Deposit Scheme (CDS Vic)

The scheme gives Victorians a 10-cent refund for every eligible can, carton and bottle they return with the option to donate the money to the Good Friday Appeal.

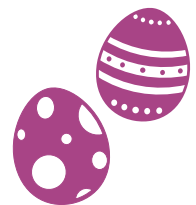
What about a fun Find Welby treasure hunt? or design your own Welby comic strip or drawing competition!

Another no cost event is to run a dress up day or costume contest. In 2022, North Fitzroy Primary School ran a 'come to school dressed as what you want to be when you grow up day - as they believe that all children should be able to look forward to growing up.



HOLD AN EVENT



An event can be a great way to bring your school community together. Simply charge an entry fee as the donation. What about a fete, a trivia night or an art sale or sausage sizzle - the options are endless!
